**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The August capital campaign is for Backpack Buddies of Erath County. They are a local, non-profit organization that provides children from food-insecure homes with healthy weekend meals during the school year. School principals and guidance counselors select the children. On Fridays, the backpacks are prepared and delivered to Stephenville ISD and the program has now expanded to include Dublin, Lingleville, Huckabay, Morgan Mill, Bluff Dale, and 3-Way ISD. In the 2022-2023 school year, they served over 300 students in Erath County. The average cost to feed 1 child per weekend is \$5.00. For 6 weeks is \$30.00, per semester is \$90.00, and per school year is \$180.00. We will take the offering for Backpack Buddies this morning.

**Sunday School Fall Start** – Join us today following morning worship as we kick off our Sunday school classes for fall! If the service concludes by 11:45, PreK – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are encouraged to go to the nursery for singing with CoriAnn or Janna before they break into Sunday school classes.
