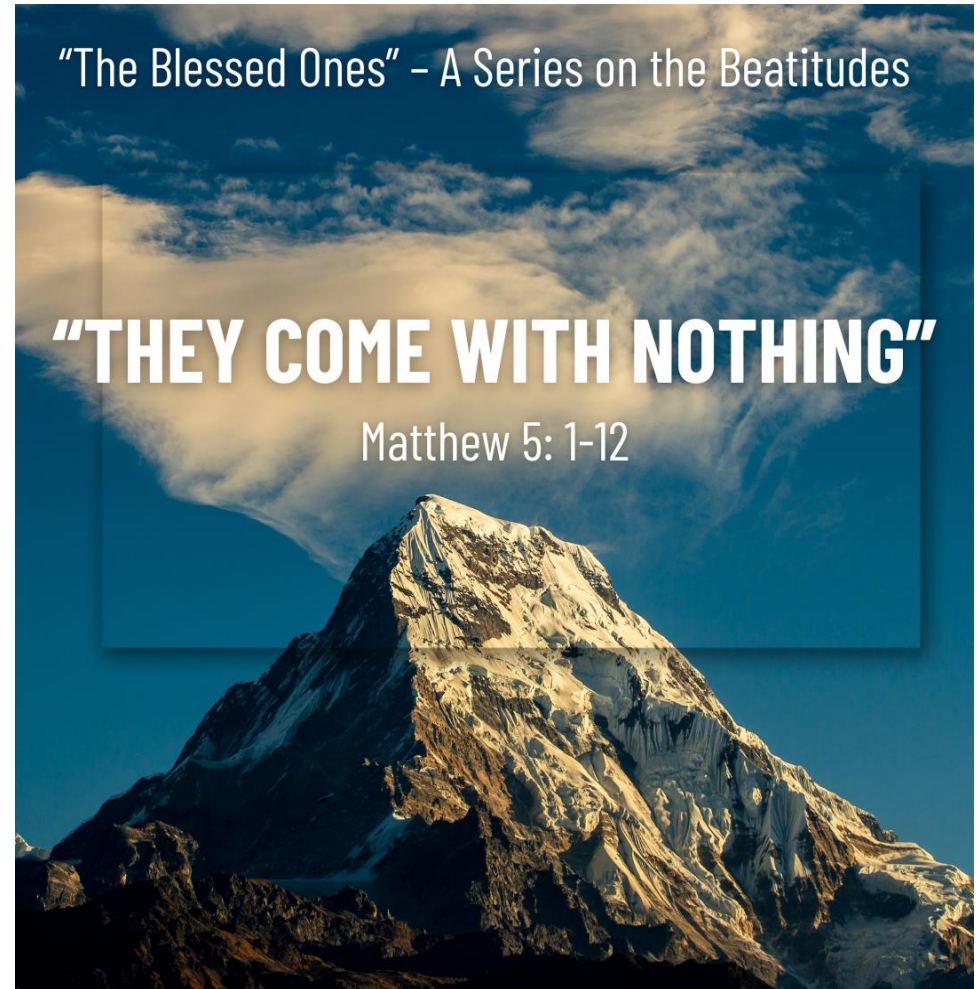

Monthly Capital Campaign – The April capital campaign is for our Resonate Global Missionaries, Johnny and Kim Gryglewicz." Their vision is to love and serve the people of Haiti and to share in Gospel-centered, whole-community transformation. Due to the worsening security crisis in the country, the Gryglewicz's have relocated to South Florida. Johnny is continuing to remotely oversee the field office and is working with Haitian pastors in Florida to plant churches. Both Kim and Johnny are connecting with the Haitian diaspora community as well as assisting with the increased immigration of Haitians fleeing the devastating gang violence.
