## **\*Upcoming Dates to Remember:**

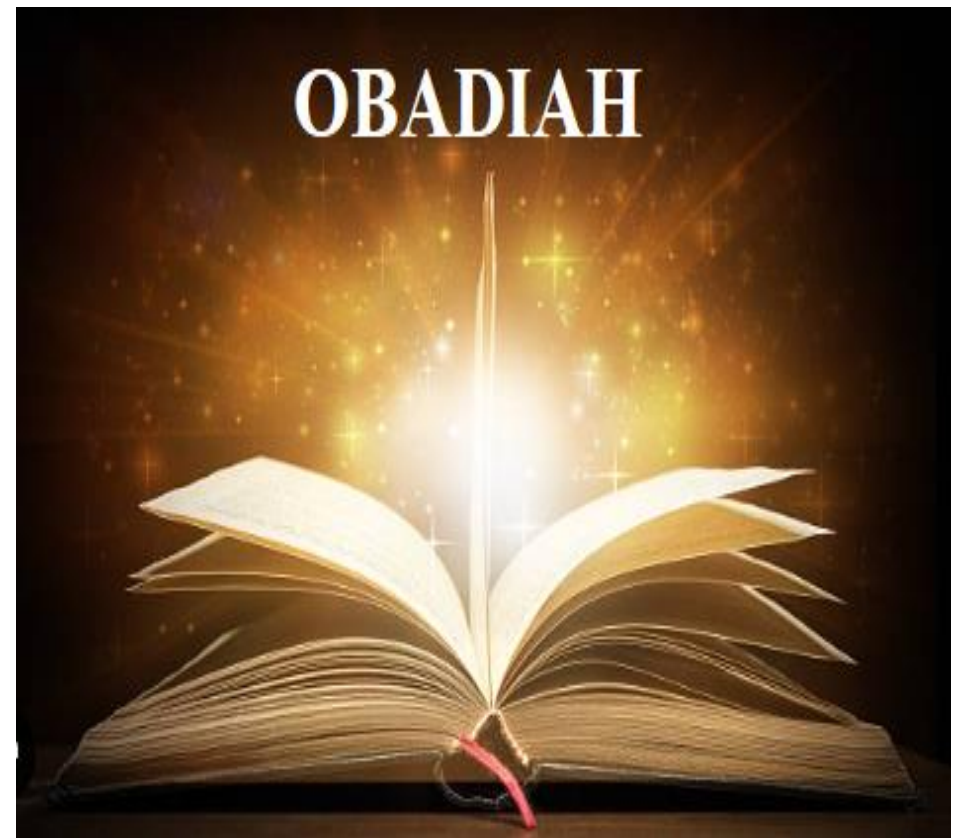
